

Dear Mr Vara,

The British Business Bank has today published updated data which shows the regional distribution of loans offered under the Coronavirus Business Interruption Loan Scheme (CBILS) and the Bounce Back Loan Scheme (BBLs).

The data shows that these schemes, which closed on 31 March 2021, were distributed evenly across the UK's three Devolved Nations and nine regions, helping businesses to access the finance they needed to support their businesses during the Covid19 outbreak.

I am pleased to inform you that in **North West Cambridgeshire**, **3,378** loans worth **£138,739,594** have been offered across both CBILS and BBLs.
